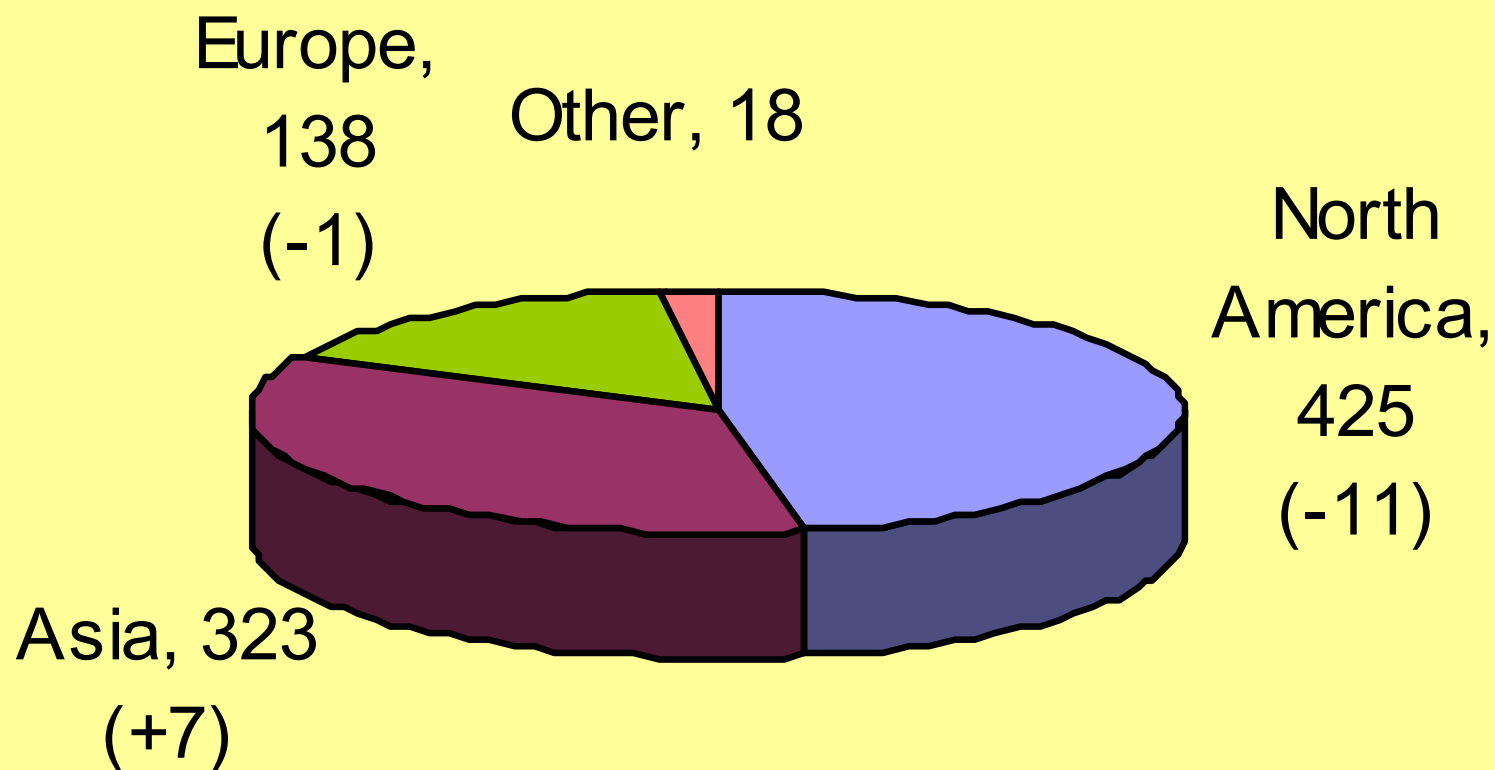

Data as of May 12th

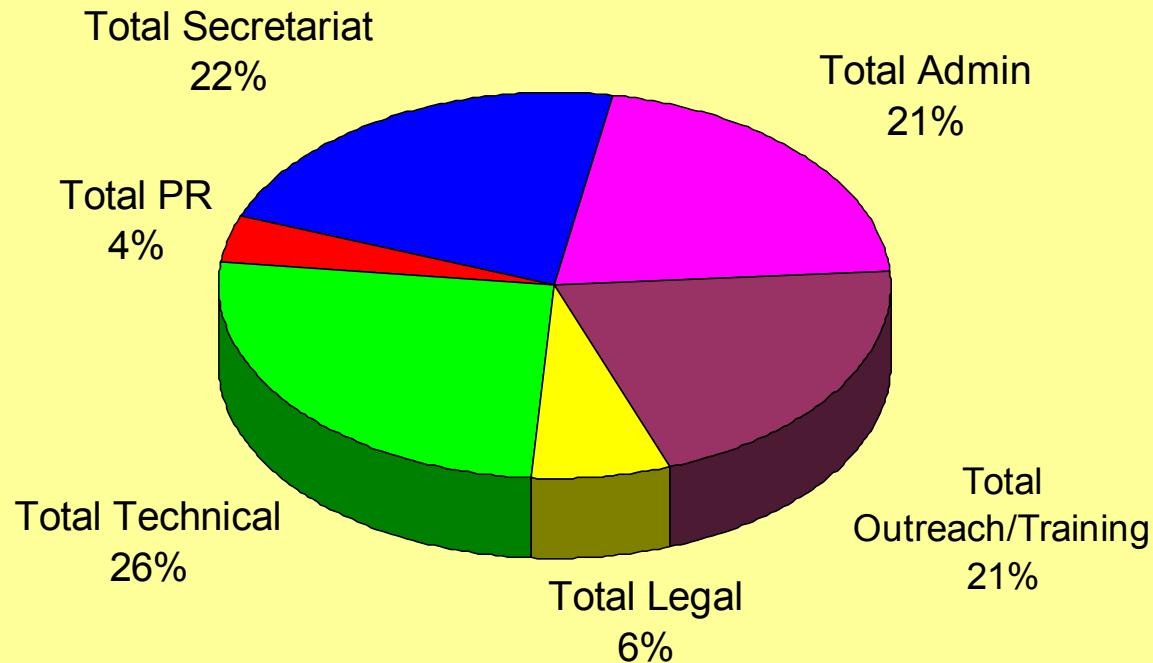
# Current Members by Region – as of May 10th

# Purpose of the PCI-SIG

- The Corporation and its Members are committed to monitoring and enhancing the development of the Peripheral Component Interconnect ("PCI"). The Corporation was formed to achieve this purpose by among other matters (1) striving for compatibility of all PCI specification revisions or addenda; (2) maintaining the PCI architecture as a simple, easy to implement, stable technology in the spirit of its design; (3) contributing to the establishment of PCI as an industry standard; and (4) maintaining the technical longevity of the PCI architecture. The Corporation may make or propose technical standards and interface with other groups or bodies developing such standards.
